1 RULES

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the racing rules of sailing 2009-2012, the appropriate Class Rules and the organiser's supplementary sailing instructions.

2 ADVERTISING

The event is designated Category C.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to RS 200 dinghies whose owner is a member of the RS Class Association and Skiffs (as defined below) belonging to, or under the control of, members of clubs affiliated to the RYA. All boats shall have an individual recognised sail number.

Asymmetric Skiff – Monohull Asymmetric with a PY of 930 or less.

Single Sail Skiff – Monohull single sailed boats with a PY of 990 or less.

- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter at registration or by completing the appropriate entry form and sending it, together with the required fee to:

- 3.3 The organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry from any boat considered unsuitable for the event.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at registration upon receipt of a completed entry form and the appropriate fee.

7 VENUE

- 7.1 The venue will be Largs Sailing Club, located in Largs Yacht Haven.

7.2 The Race Area will be the Largs Channel.

8 THE COURSES

The courses are described in detail in the Sailing Instructions and include windward leeward and trapezoid courses.

9 SCORING

9.1 The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply.

9.2 Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

9.3 (a) When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

9.4 The Scottish Skiffs shall be scored using Portsmouth Yardstick Handicaps and average laps.

10 PRIZES

The Prizegiving will be held in Largs Sailing Club as soon as possible after racing ends, on Sunday afternoon.

11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta

12 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000 per event or the equivalent.

13 FURTHER INFORMATION

13.1 The Event notice board will be in the downstairs corridor of Largs SC.

13.2 The clubhouse will be open from 8:30am till late both days serving food and refreshments.
