

The Organizing Authority is Largs Sailing Club Notice of Race

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The Series is open to dinghies and catamarans that are helmed by members of Largs Sailing Club whose membership falls into the categories stated below:
- a) Individual Members
 - b) Family Members
 - c) Junior Members
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the paper entry form available from the RO prior to the start of each days racing. Dinghies and catamarans shall compete as a single Handicap class.
- 2.3 Entry to a race may be made at any time prior to the first warning signal for that race.

3 FEES

- 3.1 For eligible members of Largs Sailing Club no entry fee is payable.

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Registration will take place prior to the start of each days racing
- 4.2 The series racing is scheduled to take place on Sunday Afternoons with racing taking place on the dates listed below;

Series Name	Autumn Series
Dates	13 rd September Until 25th October (Amendment 1)

- 4.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is **1355**.
- 4.4 Up to two races will be scheduled to take place each day, and the warning signal for the second race will be immediately after the first race has completed.

6 VENUE

- 6.1 The Venue will be Largs Sailing Club, located in Largs Yacht Haven.
6.2 The Race Area will be the Largs Channel

7 THE COURSES

- 7.1 The courses are described in the Club Course Chart 2020 published on the LSC website Racing page.

8 MEASUREMENT

- 8.1 Each boat shall comply with their class rules in regard to measurement.
8.2 It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that their boat remains compliant with their class/rating rules.

9 RISK STATEMENT

- 9.1 Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone."

Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- a) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
- c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- e) The provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- f) The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances;
- g) It is their responsibility to familiarise themselves with any risks specific to this venue or this event drawn to their attention in any rules and information produced for the venue or event and to attend any safety briefing held for the event.

10 INSURANCE

10.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £3,000,000 per event or the equivalent.
